

Nation-authorized. Locally directed.

MANITOBA / INAWENDIWIN STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

We help Nations design and run the Inawendiwin Stewardship Program. Recurring contributions fund locally directed stewardship. Contributors who meet the protocol are Inawendiwin Partners.

Relating

Inawendiwin means relating, kinship and relational accountability to one another and to Creation. The program is named for that teaching: money follows an authorized relationship, not a marketing claim.

For Nations

Authorize the Inawendiwin Stewardship Program. Set the protocol, approve participants and direct uses. Waaseyak supports program design, business engagement and administration. Nations and authorized Indigenous bodies hold authority; they are not listed as Partners.

For businesses

Contribute under the Nation-set protocol. Once the contribution is received and the protocol and reporting are verified, you are listed as an Inawendiwin Partner for the stated period. An inquiry or roster seat alone does not confer Partner status.

A Manitoba pathway.

Nations set the protocol. Businesses contribute on a recurring basis. Recognition is earned only for the period the rules are met, and it sits on a public register. That is the Inawendiwin Stewardship Program.

Begin the relationship. Send an authorization inquiry or request a Partner seat at inawendiwin.com/join. Written Nation authorization comes first.

How contributions fund care.

Waaseyak Corp. administers program design, participation and reporting under Nation authority. The 1% contribution remits 100% to the Nation.

Administration ≠ contribution. Same company, two roles.

Business track. A Nation-approved percentage of defined revenue, a customer-facing amount or a fixed annual tier.

Waaseyak contribution. 1% of its own client revenue, paid from Waaseyak revenue, not taken from Nations. That 1% remits 100% to the Nation. When received and verified, it may list Waaseyak as an Inawendiwin Partner for that period, on the same terms as any contributor.

Specialist track. 1% of fees on a Waaseyak-referred file only. Independent work is outside the protocol. Seat fee ≠ stewardship contribution. A specialist becomes a Partner only once the contribution is received and the protocol verified for the stated period.

What Partner listing proves

A stewardship contribution and a relationship.

Not charity theatre. Not a marketing claim.

Partner listing proves only that the named protocol, contribution, and reporting rules were met for a stated period.

It is not Indigenous ownership, consent, social licence, carbon neutrality, or a product-wide sustainability rating.

Contributions do not buy consent, satisfy consultation or accommodation, waive rights, or replace regulatory duties.

Waaseyak administers. Inawendiwin is a client file when a Nation authorizes it.

No Nation is treated as a signed client.

Program scope. Our focus is stewardship programming. Waaseyak Corp. administers under Nation authority. Inawendiwin is a client file when a Nation authorizes it. No Nation is treated as a signed client.

Contributions do not confer ownership or a right to profits. Partner status records protocol, contribution and reporting for a stated period.

Written agreements must identify the contribution recipient, handling arrangements and approval controls before contributions begin. No existing trust or custody arrangement is represented here.
